Naming Rules

Which name you use is of course your choice. But please notice following restrictions:

- The names must be acknowledged by the registry office as acceptable given first names; double names are not accepted. Furthermore, the names have to be spelled without any special characters other than German umlauts.
- Surnames or names of companies are not accepted unless they are first names as well.
- The gender has to be regarded. In even-numbered years Lows are given female names and Highs male names. In odd-numbered years it is the opposite.

If there are any questions about a name or the possibility of a name just contact us and we will check and if needed find a solution.

Additional Information

It is common practice but we do not guarantee that media use these names for Highs and Lows in their weather reports and programmes. Nobody is obliged to use the names.

We can not specify at which point in time a High or Low will be named. This is at the discretion of the meteorologist on duty. Furthermore, the meteorologist will decide which Highs and Lows are given names. Generally, pressure areas are named when they reach a level of importance for the general weather pattern in Central Europe.

Normally, we publish the name of the godparent on our homepage. The declaration of a website is optional. We also reserve the right to link to the given homepage or refuse a link. In general, the links stay active for two years and will be removed after this time. Please note that as the basis for a link, natural persons only are allowed and legal persons will not be accepted. Should you sponsor more than one vortex per year, only one link is allowed. Linking to any website costs €25,-.
